Judith's Monthly Update

BROADBAND: Currently there are 22 businesses taking advantage of our fast broadband arrangements with Exponential/BongolT. We are in the process of renewing their contract and would like to invite new businesses to join. Please also confirm that your business wants to renew. Contact Judith for further details.

ESTATE LIGHTS: All the lights on the estate had their bulbs renewed and should be working. Please get in touch with Judith if you detect a faulty light.

MAIN GATE: Discussions are ongoing regarding the design of our main gate on Riverside Road near Livra. It is vulnerable to being damaged and has needed frequent repairs.

CCTV EQUIPMENT: Our equipment is ageing and needs updating. A meeting has been arranged for July to discuss.

PARKING: At the open meeting a number of businesses expressed concern that parking is getting more and more difficult on the estate. We all have experienced not finding a free parking space on our estate roads and some of us are suspicious that outsiders, not working on the estate, are parking their cars here early in the morning before going to work. We have therefore started to look into how we can control parking, at least making sure that all parking spaces on our roads are available to our businesses.

BID LEVEL INVOICES: The invoices for BID Levy 2017/18 have not yet been sent out by Wandsworth Council. They were due to be despatched in early April. The delay is due to administration issues. We will alert you via Facebook and Twitter when the invoices are due to be sent out.

WIMBLEDON STADIUM DEVELOPMENT: You will have already seen some changes on the former Greyhound Stadium site. The Wednesday and Weekend Markets have gone and parking is no longer available. The developers are in the process of appointing a demolition contractor and will inform us in due course.

PLANNING APPLICATION: Please note that planning application for developing Unit 72 Riverside Road has been filed with Wandsworth Council. See their website for Planning Application 2017/1973. Comments have to be filed by the 19th of May.
